

PACIFIC COAST FOAM CREATES GIANT WATER DRAGON FOR RAGING WATERS SAN JOSE'S NEW RIDE, THE DRAGON'S DEN

SAN DIEGO — June 9, 2003 — Pacific Coast Foam (PCF) has created a 10-foot-tall water spraying dragon for Raging Waters San Jose's new ride, The Dragon's Den (see attached photo), according to Scott J. Buckley, vice president of marketing for PCF, San Diego's largest supplier and installer of expanded polystyrene (EPS) foam architectural shapes and accents.

PCF's Art Department, headed by Colin Parmalee, designed, fabricated and finished the dragon, which is the centerpiece of the new Dragon's Den Ride. Renderings and a clay maquette of the dragon were provided in the design process. The fabrication started from foam using a combination of L&C machines and hand sculpting. Water lines were also installed for spraying water from the dragon's nostrils and tail. A polyurethane hard coat was then applied and the dragon was faux finished. Raging Waters performed the installation on-site in conjunction with Pro Slide, the water slide manufacturer located in Canada.
