

PACIFIC COAST FOAM TO PROVIDE INTERIOR ARCHITECTURAL ACCENTS FOR TRUMP'S SPOTLIGHT 29 CASINO RENOVATION AND EXPANSION IN COACHELLA, CALIFORNIA

SAN DIEGO — July 18, 2002 — Pacific Coast Foam (PCF) is providing the custom interior architectural accents for the Spotlight 29 Casino renovation and expansion in Coachella, CA, according to Scott J.
